Important Program Information

Prior to internship participation students must:

- Meet background and criminal check requirements
- Obtain and pass a health screening & drug test at their own expense
- Purchase uniform

Upon successful completion of HLTH-8001C (40 hours of classroom instruction) and HLTH-8021A (a 120 hour unpaid internship), you will receive a Macomb WCE Certificate and be eligible to take the National certification exam.

Phlebotomy HLTH-8001C

Gain knowledge and skills to work as a certified phlebotomist in offices, laboratory or hospital settings. This one class will take you from beginning to advanced phlebotomy, and includes laboratory practice. Perform a minimum of 100 venipunctures, as required for certification as a phlebotomist.

Although a High School diploma or GED is not a requirement for this class, many employers require it prior to internship participation. Text required - see page 51. (20 sessions)
