

Ceramics Class Supplies & Fee Structure

Beginning Ceramics (ARTS-9001)

Material fee of \$20 which is payable to the Anton Center at the first session includes 1 box clay and firing time. Additional boxes of clay are \$15 each.

Additional supplies to bring with you:

- Throwing Kit (from Michael's or the Big Ceramics Store online) (see picture below)
- Towel
- Paring knife

Students can bring the following items or borrow them from the Anton Center

- Paint brushes (chip brushes)
- Rubber ribs
- Scoring tools: saw blade, comb, fork, etc.

Surface Design (ARTS-9002)

Material fee of \$40 which is payable to the Anton Center at the first session includes 1 box clay, firing time and other supplies. Additional boxes of clay are \$15 each.

Additional supplies to bring with you:

- Black Sharpie
- Can of Krylon Crystal Clear Spray coating
- Respirator or dust mask
- Old plastic credit card or similar (to be used as spreader)
- Rubber gloves

Students can bring the following items or borrow them from the Anton Center

- Paint brushes
- Turpentine
- Plastic spoons/knives
- 2 acetate transparencies per student
