Instructions:

1. BEFORE YOU BEGIN:

- Verify your READING score on the Placement Test. A minimum score in the READING portion is required. COMPASS READING requires a score of 60 or higher or ASSET READING requires a score of 38 or higher.
- If your READING score does not meet the minimum required, simply contact the Counseling & Advising office at 586.286.2228 to schedule a Group Orientation.

2. WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT:

- Allow 30-45 minutes to complete the computer portion.
- Quizzes will be asked during Online Orientation. Correct answers are required in order to proceed. Also requires successful completion of an Exit Quiz.
- Be prepared to return to campus within 10 business days to meet with Counseling & Advising faculty. The available dates and times are listed above. You will review your Placement Test results, learn about registration procedures, and discuss goals and course selection. This is also a good opportunity to ask any questions you may have.
