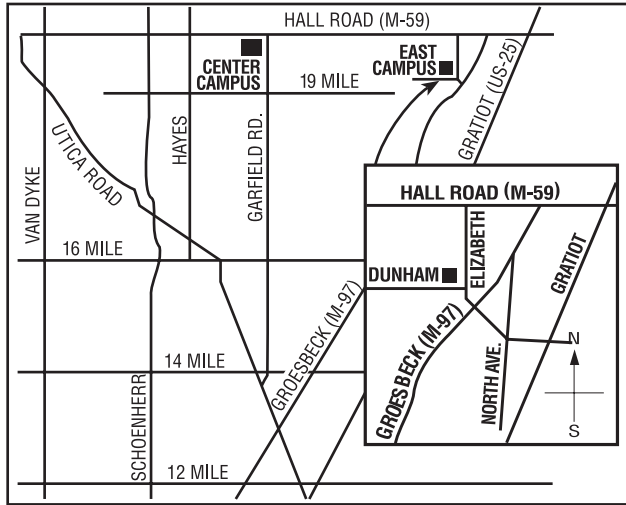

## Why Fire Science?

Fire fighting has come a long way in recent years. Today, fire protection, suppression, and prevention have become a science. It requires highly skilled professionals to help protect communities and organizations from the damaging and deadly effects of fire and health hazards. The Fire Science program at Macomb will develop your technical and operational capabilities as well as leadership and management skills in the areas of municipal, industrial, and business fire protection.

## Career Opportunities

If you are considering a career in fire service, Macomb's Fire Science program is for you. The courses provide you with the skills and knowledge for a career in areas such as fire fighting, insurance, fire investigation, and industrial safety. Many fire departments in Michigan require you to have an associate's degree in fire science before they will consider you for employment.

## The Program

Macomb's Fire Science program provides a comprehensive study in many specialized areas of fire protection, including loss prevention, industrial safety, and arson investigation along with fire fighting tactics and strategies. New areas of study are periodically added to keep up with the emerging needs of community and industrial protection. You can also concentrate your studies in fire science in conjunction with other public service areas such as emergency medical technician or law enforcement.

## The Faculty

Macomb's Fire Science faculty are dedicated professionals who are experts within their areas of specialization. In addition to teaching, they are frequently called upon to serve as consultants to insurance companies, private industry, and municipal governments. Their first concern, though, is for their students and their commitment to excellence in teaching.
