Dear Macomb Community College Student:

Private scholarships provide an excellent source of funding for Macomb Community College students. Macomb receives contributions from private donors to assist students with their educational expenses. Students are encouraged to apply for these scholarships beginning in March 2009. Recommended deadlines to apply are March–July for Fall semester and August–November for Winter semester. Scholarship applications are accepted on a rolling basis, as long as funds are available. Scholarships are awarded on either an academic year or a semester basis.

All scholarship applications are reviewed by the Macomb Scholarship Selection Committee. The applications are evaluated based on quality of essay, student’s activities, community service, grade point average, etc. Students should submit a complete application that demonstrates why they deserve to receive a scholarship. The student’s application is compared with other scholarship applicants. Therefore, it is recommended students attach items to their application that enhance their qualifications and assist the committee in making an overall determination of how deserving the student is to receive a scholarship. Many times, it helps the committee to know if there are special circumstances that could be addressed with scholarship funding, as well as how the funds will help the student succeed in his/her educational goals.

Scholarship Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

Q: Do I have to fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to receive a scholarship?

A. Not necessarily; there are scholarships not based on financial need. However, you will have more financial funding options if you do complete the FAFSA.

Q. If I am on financial aid probation, can I receive a scholarship?

A. Yes, if the scholarship doesn't require the student to make satisfactory academic progress. However, you must meet the grade point average required for the scholarship each semester of the award.

Q. How do I apply for a private scholarship?

A. Complete the private scholarship application form and submit the required documents (information is available on the Macomb Community College website at www.macomb.edu/financialaid or on-campus at the Financial Aid Office). It is your responsibility to submit all documents required for scholarship consideration. All materials must be submitted together with the application to the Financial Aid Office, either south or center campus. Incomplete applications will be denied scholarship consideration for the academic year in which the application is received; however, if denied, you can reapply for the next academic year.

Q. How are the scholarship awards determined?

A. The Scholarship Selection Committee reviews complete scholarship applications and selects recipients based on the quality of the application and the requirements of the scholarship. In some cases, departments and/or faculty make the scholarship selection.

Q. Can I apply for more than one scholarship?

A. Yes, you may apply for all scholarships for which you meet the eligibility requirements. Most scholarships are awarded for two semesters (fall and winter). However, there are limited scholarship awards made for the winter semester. Due to the high demand for scholarship dollars, you can receive only one scholarship per academic year and it may or may not cover all tuition costs.

Q. Will a scholarship affect my other financial aid awards?

A. If you are receiving federal, state or institutional need-based financial aid, your total aid cannot exceed your financial need and cost of attendance at Macomb Community College.

Q. When and how will I be notified if I receive a scholarship?

A. You should allow a minimum of four weeks after the date the Financial Aid Office receives your scholarship application for a decision. All applicants are notified in writing of the Committee's decision.

Q. If I have received a scholarship, can I reapply?

A. Yes, you may reapply for scholarship consideration for the next academic year. Remember, you can only receive one scholarship per academic year.

Q. When will I receive the money from the scholarship?

A. Scholarship recipients will have the scholarship applied first to their tuition and fees. If the scholarship covers costs beyond tuition and fees, the remaining funds will be paid to you in a refund approximately two weeks after the 100% refund period after the start date of all classes.

Q. Can I use the scholarship to buy books?

A. Yes, if your scholarship covers expenses beyond tuition and fees. If the scholarship is limited to tuition and fees only, you cannot use the scholarship to buy books.

Q. Will I be awarded the scholarship in time to pay for my classes?

A. It depends on when you apply for the scholarship. If you haven't received official notification of your scholarship award, you should be prepared to pay your tuition and then be reimbursed.

Q. If I already paid for my classes, will I be reimbursed?

A. Yes, you will be reimbursed approximately two weeks after the 100% refund period of all of your classes and/or according to the regular refund schedule. If you have late start classes within the semester, you may not be fully reimbursed until after all classes have started.

Q. What happens if I am not registered for 12 credits and the scholarship requires full-time enrollment?

A. You will not be eligible for the scholarship unless you are in a program that has a different credit hour requirement for full-time (e.g. an exception may be made for nursing students).

Q. If I drop any classes during the semester, do I have to pay the scholarship back?

A. If you officially drop your classes before the semester begins and during the 100% refund period, you do not need to pay back the funds. If you officially withdraw after the 50% refund period, you do not have to repay the scholarship. However, if you fail to attend any classes and receive the scholarship, you are required to repay the funds.

Note: Scholarship funds are provided by our donors to assist you with your academic endeavors. Honoring the scholarship requirements is the highest form of gratitude and reflects positively on you and the College.

Private Scholarship Application Instructions

All private scholarship applications submitted must include:

- 1. Private scholarship application form.** Be sure all items are completed legibly (attach an additional sheet of paper, if necessary).
- 2. Private scholarship checklist.** This form allows you to tell us for which scholarships you are applying.
- 3. Two signed letters of recommendation from two different people.** These letters can be written by high school or college counselors, faculty members, guidance counselors, professional colleagues, case workers or other professionals. The letters must be on official letterhead. The letters should also address the student's specific goals in career fields as stated in the scholarship. The date on the letter cannot be older than six months.
- 4. Academic transcripts.** Transcripts must be from high schools (if no colleges attended) and all colleges previously attended. Current Macomb Community College students must submit a copy of their transcript that includes a cumulative GPA; an unofficial copy from WebAdvisor is acceptable.
- 5. Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).** If applying for a scholarship based on financial need, the FAFSA must be received by the Financial Aid Office at the time of scholarship application. If not received at the time of application, the student **will not** be considered for a need based scholarship.
- 6.** Additional documents and/or essays that are required for specific scholarships must be included with the application. Only one essay is required per application.

All applicants must submit the above information for scholarship consideration.

All materials must be included together. Do not submit items separately. Applications which are incomplete will not be considered and the student will be denied. The student is responsible to be sure the application is complete before submitting to the Financial Aid Office.

Students will receive written notification of scholarship decisions after the committee has reviewed applications. If the student's application is sent to a department/faculty for selection, the student will be notified and additional time will be required for the response.

Students must maintain the minimum grade point average (GPA) and the enrollment status stated in the scholarship criteria for all semesters for which the award is made. The scholarship will be cancelled if the student's GPA falls below that required by the donor.

NOTE: The private scholarship application included in this booklet is to apply for scholarships administered through the Macomb Community College Financial Aid Office. If a departmental contact is listed for a scholarship, please contact the individual department for specific application requirements.

- award is for tuition and fees
- renewable, based on application

Encourages scholastic achievement and the academic growth of returning adult students who are single parents.

- half-time enrollment (6 credit hours or more) each semester of award
- financial need (FAFSA required)
- Macomb County resident
- non-renewable
- selection based on application, commitment to achieving educational goals and compliance with the scholarship criteria

Alan Anderson Memorial Scholarship

Established in memory of Alan Anderson to provide scholarship assistance to students who demonstrate a commitment to automotive programs and are enrolled in the Automotive Technology program at Macomb Community College.

- completed 12 credit hours at Macomb
- enrolled full time in the Automotive Technology program
- minimum GPA 3.0 each semester of award
- financial need (FAFSA required)
- letter of recommendation from program instructor
- award is for tuition, fees and books

Professor Henry W. Anderson Culinary Arts Memorial Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship was established in memory of Professor Anderson, who was instrumental in the initial planning of the culinary arts facility at Macomb's Center Campus. - student must be entering their second semester in the Macomb Culinary Institute
- half-time enrollment (6 credit hours or more) each semester of award
- minimum GPA 3.0 each semester of award
- award is for tuition and educational expenses
- brief biography describing education and career goals in culinary arts and /or hospitality industry
- two letters of recommendation must accompany the application. Recommendation letter **cannot** be from a Macomb Community College culinary arts instructor

Patricia Anne Apfel Memorial Endowed Scholarship

Established in memory of Patricia Anne Apfel, who had a life-long interest in theater arts. This scholarship is to assist students whose career goals are to contribute to the performing arts by writing, teaching and/or performing.

- preference to students with financial need (FAFSA suggested)
- preference to Macomb County residents
- half-time enrollment (6 credits or more) each semester of award
- minimum GPA of 3.0 each semester of award
- award is for tuition and fees
- students must be enrolled in Media Communication Arts, Speech Communication or certificate in Music Performance

Eleanor Marecki Balchan Memorial Scholarship

Established by the family, friends, and colleagues of the late Eleanor Marecki Balchan, a former professor at Macomb Community College. The scholarship provides financial assistance to students interested in speech and pursuing a speech or teaching degree.

- 24 semester hours or more completed at the time of award
- half-time enrollment (6 credit hours or more) each semester of award
- minimum GPA 3.2 each semester of award
- award is for tuition, fees, and/or books, and/or expenses to compete in speech competitions sponsored by the College
- brief summary of educational goals in pursuing speech or a teaching degree
- nomination by a Macomb speech professor; letter must accompany application (student cannot be related by blood or marriage to nominator)
- preference to students 24 years of age or older at time of nomination, raising a family, and seeking a college degree to improve their ability to provide for their family as a secondary wage earner. Documentation to support these situations must be submitted with application.
- one-\$500 scholarship awarded each academic year, based on funds available

Duane and Christine Belles Endowed Scholarship

Established by Theresa Fugiel in memory of her son-in-law, Duane Belles, and in honor of her daughter, Christine. The scholarship provides financial assistance to students returning to school for retraining or a career change.

- half-time enrollment (6 credit hours or more) each semester of award
- financial need (FAFSA required)
- business major
- out of high school for at least two years
- minimum GPA 2.5 each semester of award

Richard and Susan Bingham Family Endowed Scholarship

Established to provide financial support to qualified students at Macomb Community College.

- half-time enrollment (6 credit hours or more) each semester of award
- minimum GPA 2.5 each semester of award
- award is for tuition, fees and books

Ronald L. Bonkowski Memorial Endowed Scholarship

Established to honor the memory of Ronald L. Bonkowski, dedicated community leader, a man who loved his family and served youth and adults whenever possible. He served as a Warren City Council member and former Mayor of the City of Warren. This scholarship provides financial assistance to students to help them meet their educational goals.

- minimum GPA of 2.0 each semester of award
- award is for tuition, fees and books

Robert Boulton Memorial Scholarship

Established in memory of Robert Boulton, an alumnus of Macomb Community College, to provide financial assistance to students pursuing any Associate's or Certificate program within the Engineering and Advanced Technology area.

- half-time enrollment (6 credit hours or more) each semester of award
- minimum GPA of 2.5 each semester of award
- preference to Macomb County residents
- preference to students enrolled in metrology classes
- award is for tuition, fees and books

Sonya Brett Business and Information Technology Memorial Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship was established in memory of Sonya Brett, a professor of Business Administration at Macomb Community College for 43 years, who believed in the importance of higher education.

- enrolled in either the Business or Information Technology program
- completed 24 semester hours or more at time of award
- full-time enrollment (12 credit hours or more) each semester of award
- minimum GPA 2.8 each semester of award
- award is for tuition, fees and books

Sonya Brett Memorial Endowed Nursing Scholarship

Established in memory of Sonya Brett, a professor at the College, this scholarship provides financial assistance to students enrolled in the Nursing program at Macomb Community College.

- enrolled in the Macomb Community College Nursing program
- completed first semester of program
- minimum GPA 2.5 each semester of award
- half-time enrollment (6 credit hours or more) each semester of award
- award is for tuition, fees and books

Burtek, Incorporated Scholarship

Provides financial support to students enrolled in the Welding program at Macomb Community College.

- enrolled in Welding program
- half-time enrollment (6 credit hours or more) each semester of award
- minimum GPA 2.0 each semester of award
- preference to veterans with combat service. If no veterans with combat service apply, than any veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces will be considered. **Documentation of military service required at time of application.**
- award is for tuition, fees and books

Brian W. Caldwell Memorial Endowed Scholarship

Established by Sharon and William Caldwell, in memory of their son, Brian, to provide financial assistance to Product Development students enrolled in an internship at Macomb Community College.

- half-time enrollment (6 credit hours or more) each semester of award
- minimum GPA 3.0 each semester of award
- enrolled in internship program
- award is for tuition, fees and books
- preference to students with financial need (FAFSA suggested)
- brief summary of applicant's educational goals in chosen field

Mark E. Caporali Memorial Scholarship

Established to honor the memory of Mark E. Caporali, history professor at Macomb Community College since 1967.

- half-time enrollment (6 credit hours or more) each semester of award
- minimum GPA 2.5 each semester of award
- preference to applicants studying history
- brief biography describing applicant's accomplishments and goals
- award is for tuition, fees and books

Melanie Lynn Carlson Memorial Endowed Scholarship

Honors the memory of Melanie Lynn Carlson, a former student in the Veterinary Technician program. The scholarship provides tuition assistance to students in the Veterinary Technician program.

- students must be enrolled in the Veterinary Technician program for at least one semester at Macomb Community College
- financial need (FAFSA required)
- minimum GPA 3.0 each semester of award
- renewable, based on application
- essay explaining the student's educational and career goals in veterinary medicine and why he/she should receive the scholarship
- recipients required to write a thank you note to the donor and submit academic progress reports each semester
- two-\$500 scholarships awarded annually, based on funds available

August C. and Margaret M. Cerku Academic Endowed Scholarship

Established by the family of August and Margaret Cerku to recognize their lifelong commitment to higher education.

- half-time enrollment (6 credit hours or more) each semester of award
- preference to an honorably discharged veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces or to the child or grandchild of such a veteran; **discharge papers or proof of veteran's organization membership required at time of application**
- minimum GPA of 2.5 each semester of award
- preference to Macomb County residents
- award is for tuition, fees and books
- 12 semester hours or more completed at the time of the award
- financial need (FAFSA required)

Chrysler Foundation Scholarship

This scholarship is directed to students pursuing a degree in Business, Engineering, Automotive Technology, Information Technology and Product Development.

- minimum GPA 3.0 each semester of award
- half-time enrollment (6 credit hours or more) each semester of award
- enrolled in Business, Engineering, Product Development or Information Technology program at Macomb Community College
- award is for tuition, fees and books

Clawson–Troy Elks Music Scholarship

Established to provide financial assistance to students participating in the Macombers' music program at Macomb Community College.

- minimum enrollment 10 credit hours or more each semester of award
- minimum GPA 2.5 each semester of award
- students must be actively participating in the Macombers
- contact the Music Department, Center Campus at 586.286.2044 for further information

Cops for Kids—Sullivan/Sulik Memorial Scholarship

Funded by Cops for Kids, St. Clair Shores, to recognize and reward students with a potential to succeed in a career in law enforcement or fire science.

- full-time enrollment (12 credit hours or more) each semester of award
- minimum high school GPA of 2.5 (high school transcript required)
- award is for tuition and fees
- St. Clair Shores resident
- selection based on financial need and commitment to a career in law enforcement or fire science
- renewable, based on application
- essay on why applicant wants to go into the profession of law enforcement or fire science
- one recipient chosen from each of the three school districts in St. Clair Shores (South Lake, Lakeshore and Lakeview)
- cannot be related to police or fire personnel
- must maintain 3.0 GPA, maintain a clean driving record and have no criminal history while in the program

To honor the women who served in our country's armed forces, especially the late Major Rita M. Danielski, USA and M/Sgt. Esther (Danielski) Daniels, USA. - minimum GPA 3.0 each semester
- half-time enrollment (6 credit hours or more) each semester of award
- preference to applicants who have ROTC or prior/current honorable military service
- pursuing an associate's degree at Macomb Community College
- applicants related to the donor are not eligible for the scholarship
- two scholarships awarded annually, based on funds available

Tarik and Helen Daoud Endowed Scholarship
