

Articulation Agreement

Between
Macomb Community College
and
**Warren Consolidated Schools' Career
Prep Center**

This agreement is made this 28th day of June, 2010, by and between Macomb Community College (MCC) and Warren Consolidated Schools' Career Prep Center (hereinafter called WCS CPC).

WHEREAS, the parties wish and intend by the Agreement to set forth the terms and conditions of engaging in an educational program to help eligible participating students continue their education toward an Associate Degree in Early Childhood Studies.

MCC and WCS CPC agree that students graduating from the Early Child Development/Teacher Cadet Program (CIP 19.0700) at WCS CPC who meet the following requirements will receive select credit in the Early Childhood Studies program (CIP 19.0708) at Macomb Community College.

1. Student must successfully complete WCS CPS's Early Child Development/Teacher Cadet Program with and 80% ("B") average and an overall GPA of 2.0.
2. Student has received recommendation from high school Early Development/Teacher Cadet Program instructor.
3. Student must enroll in the Early Childhood Studies program at Macomb Community College within 3 years of high school graduation.
4. Course credit will be added to the student's transcript upon successful completion of Early Childhood Studies course(s) per this agreement and payment of the transaction fee (\$5.00 as of the date of this agreement) per course. Regular tuition and fees for credit granted under this agreement will be waived.
5. Applicants for credit must meet all college admission requirements and be an enrolled/registered student in good standing.

Upon completion of ECHS-1100 and ECHS 1200 (with a grade of “B” or higher) in the Early Childhood Studies program at MCC, the student meeting these requirements will receive the following credit(s):

Student completing 1 year H.S. Program earns ECHS 1800 – 3 credits
Student completing 2 years H.S. Program earns ECHS 1800- 3 credits and ECHS 1810 – 3 credits.

These institutions agree to communicate concerning curriculum changes which affect the agreed upon relationships between articulated courses at the respective schools.

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties, and all prior discussions, agreements, and understandings, weather verbal or in writing, are hereby merged into this Agreement.

No amendment or modification to this Agreement, including any amendment or modification of this paragraph, shall be effective unless the same is in writing and signed by all parties.

This agreement expires June 30, 2012.
