



**Articulation Agreement**  
between  
**Macomb Community College**  
and  
**Macomb Community College's Continuing Education Department**

This Agreement, made this 28th day of June, 2010, by and between Macomb Community College and Macomb Community College's Continuing Education Department.

WHEREAS, the parties wish and intend by the Agreement to set forth the terms and conditions of engaging in an educational program to help eligible participating students continue their education toward an Associate Degree in the Entrepreneurship Program.

Macomb Community College and Macomb Community College's Continuing Education Department agree that students whom successfully complete the Continuing Education Core Classes and meet the following requirements will receive select credit in the Entrepreneurship Certificate Program at Macomb Community College.

1. Student must successfully complete Macomb Community College's Continuing Education Core Classes.
2. Student must enroll in the Entrepreneurship Program at MCC within 2 years of completion of the Continuing Education Program.
3. Course credit will be added to the student's transcript upon successful completion of one of the selected courses and the payment of a service fee (\$5.00 as of the date of this agreement). Regular tuition and fees for credit granted under this agreement will be waived.
4. Applicants for credit must meet all college admission requirements and be an enrolled/registered student in good standing.

Upon completion of the 4 Continuing Education Core Classes listed, and one of the credit courses listed, the student meeting these requirements will receive 3 credits in BUSN 1210 Entrepreneurship Fundamentals.

Student completes all four Continuing Education classes:

1. ENTR 8000 – Be Your Own Boss
2. ENTR 8002 – Implementation, Ent. Business
3. ENTR 8003 – Marketing Strategies that Work
4. ENTR 8021 – ABC's of Entrepreneurship

Student completes – one of the following classes:

1. MKTG 1210 – Small Business Marketing
2. MGMT 1210 – Entrepreneurship and Small Business Mgmt.
3. ACCT 1070 – Accounting for Entrepreneurship

Student Receives Credit:

BUSN 1210 Entrepreneurship Fundamentals – 3 Credits

These departments of Macomb Community College agree to communicate concerning curriculum changes which affect the agreed upon relationships between articulated courses.

The Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties, and all prior discussions, agreements, and understandings, whether verbal or in writing, are hereby merged into this Agreement.

No agreement or modification to this Agreement, including any amendment or modification of this paragraph, shall be effective unless the same is in writing and signed by all parties.

This agreement expires June 30, 2012.
