

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
between
Macomb Community College
and
South Lake Public Schools

This Agreement, made this 28th day of June, 2010, by and between Macomb Community College and South Lake Public Schools.

WHEREAS, the parties which intend by the Agreement to set forth the terms and conditions of engaging in an educational program to help eligible participating students continue their education toward and **Associate Degree**.

Macomb Community College and South Lake Public Schools agree that students successfully completing the specified coursework in Mathematics in South Lake Public Schools who meet the following requirements will receive select credit in the Mathematics area at Macomb Community College.

1. Student must successfully complete South Lake Public Schools' Beginning Calculus course with a minimum B (3.0) average and be eligible for dual enrollment.
2. Student has received recommendation from high school mathematics instructor.
3. Student must enroll in MATH 1770- Analytic Geometry & Calculus II at Macomb Community College within one year of high school graduation.
4. Course credit will be added to the student's transcript upon successful completion of MATH 1770- Analytic Geometry & Calculus II at Macomb Community College and the payment of a service fee (currently \$5.00) per transaction. Regular tuition and fees for credit granted under this agreement will be waived.
5. Applicants for credit must meet all college admission requirements and be an enrolled/registered student in good standing.

Upon successful completion of MATH 1770- Analytic Geometry & Calculus II (4 semester hours) at Macomb Community College, the student meeting these requirements will receive credit for MATH 1760 – Analytic Geometry & Calculus I (4 semester hours).

These institutions agree to communicate concerning curriculum changes which affect the agreed upon relationships between articulated courses at the respective schools.

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties, and all prior discussions, agreements, and understandings, whether verbal or in writing, are hereby superseded by this Agreement.

No amendment or modification to this Agreement, including any amendment or modification of this paragraph, shall be effective unless the same is in writing and signed by all parties.

This agreement expires June 30, 2012 or whenever South Lake Public Schools changes the course of its Beginning Calculus course, whichever comes first.
