

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

for Continuing and Returning Students

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Tip 1:

Personal Information

Check and update your personal information (address, residency, program, etc.).

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Tip 2:

Temporary Exemptions

If you received temporary exemptions for placement testing or for new student orientation, schedule and complete them prior to the start of registration.

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Tip 3:

Program Update/Verification

Schedule an appointment with an academic advisor or counselor to review your program choice or next steps such as transfer to a 4-year school or the University Center.

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Tip 4:

Waivers/Overrides

Obtain any waivers or overrides you may need for next semester's classes before registering.

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Tip 5:

Transcript Information

Check your transcript information and resolve any inaccuracies.

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Tip 6:

Financial Information

- check and resolve any holds on your record
- pay any outstanding balances
- verify that your financial aid is complete and ready to use for tuition payment
- if your tuition is paid by a third party organization or company verify all required paperwork is complete for payment
- check into the availability of scholarships

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Tip 7:

Registration

Register early to get the classes you want and need.

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Tip 8:

Books

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Tip 9:

Apply for Graduation

Apply for graduation and sign up for commencement if this is your last semester.
