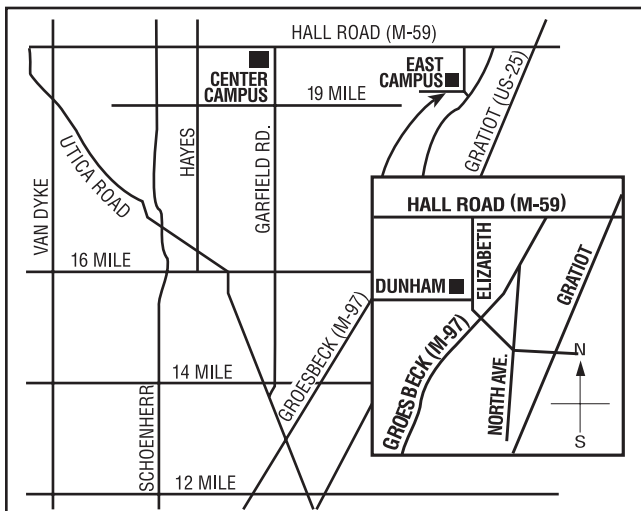

The Academy

Macomb's Basic Fire Academy is a ten-week course using the State of Michigan Office of Fire Fighter Training (OFFT) curriculum including live fire training, confined space rescue, emergency egress, water rescue, vehicle extrication, basic rope rescue, and vehicle operation.

Upon successful completion of the Academy, participants receive:

- 12 College Credits
- Live Fire Training

And are eligible to earn certification in:

- Fire Fighter I and Fire Fighter II
- Confined Space Rescue
- Hazardous Material Awareness
- Hazardous Material Operation



Graduates of Macomb's Basic Fire Academy complete a course of study and skill training that qualifies them to serve with the finest fire departments in Michigan and the Nation*.

*Depending upon individual state requirements.

Make Fire Fighting Your Career Choice!

Successful completion of a fire training program is required by most municipalities as a prerequisite to being hired as a fire fighter. A few departments may also require an associate's degree in addition to the fire academy. Many students completing our fire academy start their careers then pursue a Fire Science degree at Macomb.
