



# **Articulation Agreement**

between

**Macomb Community College**

and

**Grosse Pointe Public School System**

This agreement is made this 11th day of February, 2011, by and between Macomb Community College and Grosse Pointe Public School System.

WHEREAS, the parties wish and intend by the Agreement to set forth the terms and conditions of engaging in an educational program to help eligible participating students continue their education toward an Associate Degree in Information Technology.

Macomb Community College and Grosse Pointe Public School System agree that students successfully graduating from the Information Technology Program at Grosse Pointe Public School System who meet the following requirements will receive select credit in the Information Technology program (CIP 11.0201) at Macomb Community College.

1. Student must successfully complete Grosse Pointe Public School System's Information Technology Program with a minimum B average and an overall GPA of 3.0.
2. Student has received recommendation from high school Computer Information Systems instructor.
3. Student must enroll in the Information Technology program at Macomb Community College within 3 years of high school graduation.
4. Course credit will be added to the student's transcript upon successful completion of one required ITCS 1400 (Micros in Business) course at Macomb Community College and the payment of a \$5.00 service fee per transaction. Regular tuition and fees for credit granted under this agreement will be waived.
5. Applicants for credit must meet all college admission requirements and be an enrolled/registered student in good standing.

**No amendment or modification to this Agreement, including any amendment or modification of this paragraph, shall be effective unless the same is in writing and signed by all parties.**
