

Articulation Agreement
between
Macomb Community College
and
Romeo Community Schools

This agreement is made this 28th day of June, 2010, by and between Macomb Community College and Romeo Community Schools (RCS).

WHEREAS, the parties wish and intend by the Agreement to set forth the terms and conditions of engaging in an educational program to help eligible participating students continue their education toward an Associate Degree in Electronic Technology.

Macomb Community College and Romeo Community Schools agree that students successfully completing the Electronics Technology I program (CIP 47.0101) at Romeo High School, and who meet the following requirements will receive select credit in the Electronic Technology program (CIP 47.0101) at Macomb Community College.

Requirements:

1. Student must complete all High School electronics related courses with a minimum (B) average and an overall GPA of 2.0.
2. Student must receive recommendation from a high school Electronics instructor.
3. Student must enroll in the Electronic Technology program at Macomb Community College within 3 years of high school graduation.
4. Course credit will be added to the student's transcript upon successful completion of one semester (6 credits min) in the Electronic Technology program at Macomb Community College and the payment of a \$5.00 service fee per transaction. Regular tuition and fees for credit granted under this agreement will be waived.
5. Applicants for credit must meet all college admission requirements and be an enrolled/registered student in good standing.

Upon completion of the Romeo High School courses Electronics Technology I and Electronics Technology II, and the above requirements, the student will receive 6 credits for Macomb Community College courses ELEC 1161 and ELEC 1171.

Upon completion of the Romeo High School course IT Essentials, and the above requirements, the student will receive 6 credits for Macomb Community College courses ELEC 2650 and ELEC 2660.

These institutions agree to communicate concerning curriculum changes which affect the agreed upon relationships between articulated courses at the respective schools.

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties, and all prior discussions, agreements, and understandings, whether verbal or in writing, are hereby merged into this Agreement.

No amendment or modification to this Agreement, including any amendment or modification of this paragraph, shall be effective unless the same is in writing and signed by all parties.

This agreement expires June 30, 2012.
