

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

between

Macomb Community College

and

**Macomb Community College's
Career Academies Program**

This agreement, made this 28th day of June, 2010, by and between Macomb Community College and Macomb Community College's Career Academies Program.

WHEREAS the parties wish and intend by the Agreement to set forth the terms and conditions of engaging in an educational program to help eligible participating students continue their education toward an Associated Degree in the Veterinary Technician Program.

Macomb Community College and the Career Academies Program agree that students successfully completing the Veterinary Technician Career Academy Program who meet the following requirements will receive select credit in the Vet Tech program at Macomb Community College.

1. Student must successfully complete Macomb Community College's Vet Tech Career Academy Program and have an overall high school GPA of 2.0.
2. Student must enroll in the Vet Tech program at MCC within three (3) years of high school graduation.
3. Course credit will be added to the student's transcript upon successful completion of one VETT class and the payment of a service fee (currently \$5 per transaction). Regular tuition and fees for credit granted under this agreement will be waived.
4. Applicants for credit must meet all college admission requirements and be an enrolled/registered student in good standing.

Upon completion of the Vet Tech Career Academy and one (1) class in the Vet Tech associate degree program at Macomb Community College, the student meeting these requirements will receive one (1) credit for HHSC-1010 Animal Health Careers.

These departments of Macomb Community College agree to communicate concerning curriculum changes which affect the agreed upon relationships between articulated courses.

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties, and all prior discussions, agreements, and understandings, whether verbal or in writing, are hereby merged into this Agreement.

No amendment or modification to this Agreement, including any amendment or modification of this paragraph, shall be effective unless the same is in writing and signed by all parties.

This agreement expires June 30, 2012.
