



**Articulation Agreement  
between  
Macomb Community College  
and**

- **Chippewa Valley Schools**
- **Romeo Public Schools**
- **Utica Community Schools**
- **Warren Consolidated Career Prep Center**

This Agreement, made this 28<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2010, by and between Macomb Community College (hereinafter called Macomb) and the schools listed above.

WHEREAS, the parties wish and intend by the Agreement to set forth the terms and conditions of engaging in an educational program (CIP 15.0612) to help eligible participating students continue their education toward a Certificate and Associate Degree in Manufacturing Technology.

Macomb agrees that students graduating from a partnering secondary school who meet the following requirements will receive select credit in the Applied Technology & Apprenticeship program (CIP 15.0613) at Macomb Community College.

1. Student must successfully complete their high schools' Machining/Manufacturing program (level 1) with GPA of at least 3.0 in the technical subject areas, and an overall GPA of at least 2.0.
2. Student has received recommendation from high school instructor.
3. Student must enroll in the Applied Technology area at Macomb within 3 years of high school graduation.
4. Course credit will be added to the student's transcript upon successful completion of one Applied Technology course, completion and approval of the Application For Articulation, and the payment of a service fee (\$5.00 as of the date of this agreement). Regular tuition and fees for credit granted under this agreement will be waived.
5. Applicants for credit must meet all college admission requirements and be an enrolled/registered student in good standing in a Applied Technology & Apprenticeship Certificate or Associate Degree program.

A student who earns a C or better in one Applied Technology course and who meets these requirements will receive the following credit(s):

ATMT 1150 Machine Tool Lab I	3 credits
ATDD 1950 Drafting Essentials	2 credits
ATAM 1150 Shop Math	2 credits
ATMT 2270 CNC Concepts I	2 credits

Students, who complete Level II of the schools listed above in the Machine Tool Technology program, will also receive credit for:

ATMT 1160 Machine Tool Lab II	3 credits

Additional credit might also be earned under dual enrollment or early admission activities. Students should consult their high school instructor or counselor for additional information.

These institutions agree to communicate concerning curriculum changes which affect the agreed upon relationships between articulated courses at the respective schools.

The Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties, and all prior discussions, agreements, and understandings, whether verbal or in writing, are hereby merged into this Agreement.

No agreement or modification to this Agreement, including any amendment or modification of this paragraph, shall be effective unless the same is in writing and signed by all parties.

This agreement expires June 30, 2012.
