

**CENTER CAMPUS – SPECIAL SERVICES
NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION/COURSE PLANNING SESSIONS**

Attending a New Student Orientation/Course Planning Session is REQUIRED.

Group Orientation Option - *This option allows for interaction within a group setting (approximately 2.5 hours).* WALK-INS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN GROUP SESSIONS.

- The session begins with a group presentation, followed by brief individual assistance.
- First, an academic advisor will welcome you and explain Macomb's programs, transfer information, and student services.
- Next, a counselor will assist you to begin your educational planning including:
 - Identifying your program
 - Reviewing your assessment results
 - Suggesting courses for your first semester

IMPORTANT NOTES:

You must sign-up for New Student Orientation/Course Planning Sessions by calling the Special Services office. WALK-INS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN GROUP SESSIONS.

- Please check the Macomb Community College website for the most current dates/times/locations of these sessions as they change on a weekly basis.
- If special accommodations are needed, such as interpreters or special instructional accommodations, please schedule an appointment with one of the Special Services Counselors.
- English as a Second Language (ESL) - Students who have completed the ESL COMPASS placement test and who plan to take English for Academic Purposes (EAPP) classes, should call the special services office to schedule an ESL orientation appointment with a Special Services Counselor.
