

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

between
Macomb Community College
and
Anchor Bay High School

This Agreement is made the 28th day of June, 2010, by and between Macomb Community College (hereinafter called MCC) and the Anchor Bay Schools.

WHEREAS, the parties wish and intend by the Agreement to set forth the terms and conditions of engaging in an educational program to help eligible participating students continue their education toward an Associate Degree in Product Development.

Macomb Community College and Anchor Bay Schools agree that students successfully completing the Advanced Computer Aided Design I program (CIP 15.1301) at Anchor Bay High School, who meet the following requirements will receive select credit in the Product Development program (CIP 15.0613) at Macomb Community College.

1. Student must successfully complete the Anchor Bay High School – Advanced Computer Aided Design I with an overall GPA of 3.0.
2. Student has received recommendation from high school instructor.
3. Student must enroll in the Product Development program at Macomb Community College within 3 years of high school graduation.
4. Applicants for credit must meet all college admission requirements and be an enrolled/registered student in good standing.
5. Course credit will be added to the student's transcript upon successful completion of the appropriate advanced level course and the payment of a transaction fee (\$5.00 per transaction at the time of this agreement). Regular tuition and fees for credit granted under this agreement will be waived.

Based on the following chart, the students must successfully complete, with a grade of B or better, the appropriate course at Macomb Community College before articulated credit can be transcribed to the student's college transcript.

These institutions agree to communicate concerning curriculum changes which affect the agreed upon relationships between articulated courses at the respective schools.

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties, and all prior discussions, agreements, and understandings, whether verbal or in writing, is hereby merged into this Agreement.

No amendment or modification to this Agreement, including any amendment or modification of this paragraph, shall be effective unless the same is in writing and signed by all parties.

This agreement expires June 30, 2012.
