

**MOTORCYCLE SAFETY**

The Motorcycle Rider and Safety Education Program is conducted with Michigan Safety Education funds from a grant administered by the Michigan Secretary of State.



**Required for all Motorcycle classes:**

Protective eyewear (glasses or goggles), helmet, boots, gloves, long sleeved jacket or shirt, long pants and rain gear if needed. Bring to the first riding session and each riding session thereafter. You are required to be on time for each session and must attend each session.

You will receive approximately 16 hours of instruction in all of the BRC classes, 4 in the classroom and 12 on the range. The one weekend class is the most physically demanding. We recommend that you already know how to clutch and brake to take this class.

**Class Times/Location**

- Friday from 6-10 PM, Saturday and Sunday from 8 AM–8 PM/South Campus S101
- The first day of class will consist of classroom instruction. The class will be broken down into groups and specific riding schedules will be assigned on this day. Normally your schedule will be broken up into 2 or 4 hour blocks of riding practice. These time blocks cannot be scheduled until the first night of class, so you must be available for the entire class time shown above.

**All classes are \$25. No refunds after class has started.**

**Basic Rider Course (BRC)**

**CYCL-8000**

Learn to ride a motorcycle safely with classroom and on-range instruction. In order to pass, you must successfully complete all tests, both written and riding. Upon completion of the approved Motorcycle Safety Foundation course the Michigan Secretary of State will waive the riding skills test required for a cycle endorsement. The written test must still be taken. You should be able to ride a two-wheel bicycle and must be 15 years of age or older. Motorcycles are provided for the Basic Rider Course unless otherwise stated. (3 sessions)

**Walk-In Policy**

If the Basic Rider Class you want to register for is full, you can try to walk-in to the class. (Openings occur when there are no-shows. ) Walk-ins must arrive approximately 15 minutes prior to the start time on the first day of class. When you arrive you will be given a lottery number. Instructors will pull as many lottery numbers as there are open spaces. There are no guarantees that you will be able to get into the class. You will need to pay \$25 and you must be able to attend all the sessions. Students with an approved class re-take form will have first priority in the lottery

**Performance Based Course (PB)**

**CYCL-8002**

For students who already know how to ride a motorcycle but do not have their cycle endorsement. Students **MUST** furnish their own cycle with a clutch and proof of insurance. Bike must pass a safety inspection prior to the riding skills test. In order to pass, you must successfully complete all tests, both written and riding. Upon completion of the approved Motorcycle Safety Foundation course the Michigan Secretary of State will waive the riding skills test required for a cycle endorsement. The written test must still be taken. Note: Scooters and shiftless motorcycles are allowed but you must present proof of registration, proof of no-fault insurance and display a valid motorcycle license plate. (1 session)
