Certificate in Photographic Arts

This program is designed to enhance personal as well as career skills in preparation for entry into the exciting world of professional photography. Students who successfully complete Principles of Photography, Digital Fundamentals, Photoshop for Photographers, Digital Black & White, Travel Photography and Portraiture will earn a Macomb CCE certificate of completion. Serious students can expect to invest \$1000 or more for the technical equipment, will need to develop and maintain a diverse portfolio of work as well as a working knowledge of photographic software. Certificate can be completed within two semesters.

Classes may be taken individually or as part of the certificate program.
