

Articulation Agreement
between
Macomb Community College
and
Oakland Schools (Technical Campuses)

This Agreement, made this 28th day of October, 2010 by and between Macomb Community College and Oakland Schools (Technical Campuses).

WHEREAS, the parties wish and intend by the Agreement to set forth the terms and conditions of engaging in an educational program to help eligible participating students continue their education toward a the College Preparatory Business Certificate.

Macomb Community College and Oakland Schools (Technical Campuses) agree that students whom successfully complete their high school Business Management course and meet the following requirements will receive select credit in the College Preparatory Business Certificate at Macomb Community College.

1. Student must successfully complete their high school Business Management course.
2. Student has received the recommendation from his high school teacher.
3. Student must enroll in the College Preparatory Business Certificate Program at MCC within 2 years of completion of high school graduation.
4. Course credit will be added to the student's transcript upon successful completion of one of the selected courses and the payment of a service fee (\$5.00 as of the date of this agreement). Regular tuition and fees for credit granted under this agreement will be waived. Course grade will reflect the grade received in their high school Business Management and Ownership course
5. Applicants for credit must meet all college admission requirements and be an enrolled/registered student in good standing.

Student must successfully complete their High School Business Management course with a GPA of 2.5 or higher.

Student must complete the following 3 classes at Macomb Community College:

- MGMT 1010 - Principles of Management
- MKTG 1010 - Principles of Marketing
- ECON 1160 - Principles of Economics

Student then receives credit for:

- BUSN 1010 – Business Enterprise

Macomb Community College and Oakland schools agree to communicate concerning curriculum changes which affect the agreed upon relationships between articulated courses.

The Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties, and all prior discussions, agreements, and understandings, whether verbal or in writing, are hereby merged into this Agreement.

No agreement or modification to this Agreement, including any amendment or modification of this paragraph, shall be effective unless the same is in writing and signed by all parties.

This agreement expires June 30th, 2012.
