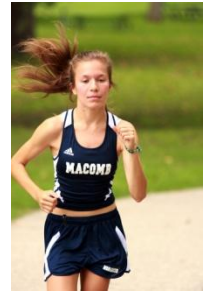

## Cross-Country Finishes Fifth

The Macomb women's cross-country team traveled to Hobbs, New Mexico this past weekend for the Division I Championships. The Monarchs finished fifth overall, one point out of fourth place. Kayla Pfund (4<sup>th</sup>) and Louisa Coppola (5<sup>th</sup>) were both named First Team All-American.

Macomb still had a very successful season, being ranked #1 multiple times during the year, and winning the Region XII and MCCAAC Championships. Many Monarchs have received honors on the year, Pfund and Coppola each received All-American, All-Region, All-MCCAAC honors. Kayla Smade and Paige Hoag each received All-Region and All-MCCAAC honors. Head Coach Kim Renas was also named Region XII and MCCAAC Coach of the Year.



## Volleyball Season Ends in District's

The Macomb volleyball team (21-17, 9-5) finished their season in the District E Tournament in Grand Rapids. The Monarchs finished fourth in the tournament after being eliminated by Schoolcraft College in four sets. Freshman Nora Fa'atiga was named to the All-Tournament team.



Several Monarchs received post-season honors, headlined by Fa'atiga, who was named to the All-Region, All-MCCAAC, and All-Eastern Conference First team, Eastern Conference Freshman of the Year, and All-Freshman Team. Lauren Holtcamp and Allegra Reckangel were each named to the All-Eastern Conference Second team. Alicia Fowler was named to the All-Eastern Conference Third team and the All-Freshman team. Tasha Evans received honorable mention All-Conference and All-Freshman team honors.

## Men's Basketball Off to Hot Start

The Macomb men's basketball team defeated Rochester College on November 15<sup>th</sup> to improve their record to 3-0. The Monarchs have won their first three games over Marygrove, Concordia, and Rochester by a combined 66 points.

Macomb is being led by sophomore Keith Paris, who is second on the team in scoring (13.3 ppg) and rebounding (7.7 rpg) and leads the team in assists (5.6 apg). Freshman Patrick Ferrell (pictured right) leads the team in scoring (20.7 ppg), including an amazing 38 point performance on Nov. 12. Ferrell tied Lee Chatman (1971-1972) and Dave Wolf (1984-1985) with the school record for field goals in a game with 17 and the 38 points in the game is tied for third all-time in school history.



The Monarchs will be traveling to Columbus St. CC for a tournament on Nov. 18-19. The team then travels to Centreville for a contest against Glen Oaks on Wed. Nov. 23, before hosting Mid-Michigan on November 29.

## Women's Basketball Undefeated

The women's basketball team is unbeaten through two games this season. The team opened the regular season with a victory at Mid-Michigan followed by a win in the team's home opener against Marygrove.



Alyssa Theut leads the team in scoring, averaging 11.5 points per game. Caitlin Carter and Kristian Hines are sharing the team lead in assists per game with five. Brianne Woycehowski leads the team in rebounding, averaging 9.5 rebounds per game.

The Monarchs schedule gets much tougher in the coming weeks, with games at Columbus St. CC and Albion College before returning home to play Rochester College at the end of November.
