

Supply List

Landscape: Oils & Pastels

Approximate cost supplies: \$290

Pastel Supplies

- Sanded pastel paper (Ersta or Wallis). Instructor will provide one sheet of paper for each student. Additional pieces may be purchased from instructor for \$8 a sheet.
- Board to mount pastel paper. (prefer foamcore or gatorfoam board)
- Masking tape
- Odorless mineral spirits or Turpenoid
- One or two old "stiff" paint brushes (old oil brushes that are no longer good for oil painting are fine. I use a one inch house painting brush most of the time.)
- Soft pastels... Nu-Pastels, pastel pencils, Rembrandts, Grumbachers, etc. The more the better because you are looking for as many colors as possible. (Note: Oil pastels are not the same as soft pastels.)
- Paper towels
- Bring your own photographs (taken by you). Do not use photos that were taken by someone else, or anything that was published.
- Camera (optional)

Oil Supplies

- Canvas - 8 x 10, 11 x 14
- Brushes - Bristle Filberts or Flats #2, 4, 6, 8 and Sable #2 & 4
- Oil Paint Colors: Yellow Ochre, Cadmium Yellow, Cadmium Orange, Cadmium Red, White, Alizarin Crimson, Ultramarine Blue, Cobalt blue, Sap Green (Dark), White (Titanium-Zinc), Burnt Sienna, Ivory Black
- Turpenoid (Webers) for cleaning brushes.
- 2 or 3 of your favorite landscape photos.
