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Before Transfer

Meet with a Walsh advisor at the Macomb University Center for assistance when choosing courses and determining credit hours. Up to an additional 20 credit hours may be earned toward your BAC degree while achieving your Macomb ABA degree. A maximum 82 transfer credit hours may transfer. Courses noted with an \* will count toward the required 30 credit hours of general education coursework. ECON 1170 must be completed at Macomb before transfer.
