- It is the responsibility of the student to be aware of changes that affect their transfer program. Students are strongly encouraged to contact Madonna University on an annual basis to review their program requirements.
- Students may concurrently be enrolled and taking courses at both Macomb and Madonna during the same semester after completing the minimum requirements for Madonna University. Meet with an academic advisor or counselor for additional information.
