2. Letter of recommendation from a professor, teacher or professional reference
3. A professional resume that contains a list of clubs, activities, accomplishments, leadership roles, jobs, education and years involved, especially those related to the automotive service field
4. A 250–300 word essay on why you are choosing to become a General Motors Automotive Technician, personal goals and your need for financial assistance
5. Copy of Macomb placement test scores (*if applicable*, transfer students may not have taken this test)
6. Copy of your valid Driver's License
7. (Optional) high school transcripts, certifications or other educational documentation
