

Security and Access to the Campus Facilities

The Macomb Community College Police Department is on duty 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. This includes officers on patrol and a staffed dispatch center. Ingress and egress of all campus buildings is monitored by the digital camera center, electronic door monitors and automatic locks. These systems are supported by College Police patrols and other monitoring alarms. Classrooms have been fitted with thumb locks to increase security and protection if circumstances warrant additional actions. The College Police Dispatch Centers (located at both South Campus and Center Campus) have one button campus lock down capability available if needed in case of an emergency. The College Police department is supported by a dedicated information technology specialist. Individual building access authorizations are granted based on policy by College Police.

Security considerations such as lighting, parking lots, and walkways are received by College Police and Plant Operations. Issues affecting security received by College Police are forwarded to the Plant Operations staff via electronic work orders. An after-hours contact system in in place between College Police and Plant Operations staff to provide immediate action as needed.
