These exams are recommended for credit by the American Council on Education and can help accelerate your path to degree completion, saving you time and money.

OBTAINING COLLEGE CREDIT

DSST® exams are accepted for credit by more than 1,900 colleges and universities nationwide, including private and public institutions. Based on the achievement of a passing test score, candidates can receive college credit and/or continuing education credit. Each institution determines its passing score requirements for a DSST®. To determine if the institution of your choice awards credit for passing DSST® scores, contact their admissions or counseling offices.

DSST® Policy

Macomb Community College currently administers all $\text{DSST}_{\circledast}$ examinations; however, credit is only granted at Macomb for a limited number of tests.

Students who do not achieve a satisfactory score may retake the same exam after 90 days from the original test date. Attempts to take the same exam before the required wait period will be invalid and test fees will be forfeited.

Test takers are not to use aids unless specified on the DSST® Auxiliary Testing Materials list. Study materials, scratch paper, electronics such as cell phones, personal handheld or wearable devices, cameras, and other communication equipment are NOT permitted in the testing room.

Please provide a current and valid form of governmentissued photo identification (driver's license, State ID, passport, military identification card). Expired identification is NOT acceptable. Student may NOT test without appropriate identification. The name on your identification must match the name used to register for the exam (including designations such as "Jr." and "III").

DSST® Exam Fee: Start at \$85 (Online \$90)

Payable by credit card (American Express, Discover, MasterCard or VISA)

DANTES-Funded Military Service Members

There is no examination fee for the first attempt of each DSST® exam. MACOMB COMMUNITY COLLEGE IS A FULLY FUNDED TEST CENTER; the administration fee is waived. Military personnel must provide two forms of identification: Armed Forces of the United States Military ID and U.S. Government or State Issued Photo ID. SCORE REPORTS

Online score reports are produced immediately after the test has ended. Candidates can log in to their account from any internetconnected device and view their scores for DSST® exams. The public speaking exam score is the only DSST® exam that cannot be viewed online. The public speaking exam score report will be emailed to candidates approximately four weeks after completion of both parts of the test. Official score reports are mailed to the candidate's designated institution (if selected at the time of testing) within 7–10 business days. If there is no designated institution at the time of testing, no score report is mailed and a DSST® Transcript Request Form will be required. The candidate will have to pay for this additional official score report.
