



The Motorcycle Rider and Safety Education program is conducted with Michigan Safety Education funds from a state grant administered by the Michigan Secretary of State. The following equipment is required: protective eyewear (glasses or goggles), helmet, boots, gloves, long sleeved shirt or jacket, long pants, and rain gear (if needed). You are required to be on time and attend all sessions. You will not be admitted to class if you are late. Students are allowed to take the Basic Rider Web Enhanced or the Basic Rider 2 courses starting at age 15, if they have a valid driver's license. All students under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian accompany them to the first class meeting. Parent signatures are required on some documents. **Basic Rider Web Enhanced \$50.00 (non-refundable) (MOTORCYCLES PROVIDED)**

**REQUIREMENT:** Must provide a valid email address upon registration. Link to the ecourse will be distributed by the College, via email, at least 1 week prior to the start date of your class. Must complete the online course prior to your class start date and bring the certificate of completion to the first class session.

The course consists of approximately 18 hours of instruction – 3 hours of online training to be completed prior to your class start date, 5 hours of classroom instruction and 10 hours of hands-on coaching. Successful completion of this course and its knowledge and skills test will result in a riding and written test waiver by the Secretary of State.

**Prerequisite:** Ability to ride a bicycle (18 Contact Hours)

**Basic Rider 2 – Returning Rider \$50.00 (non-refundable)**

A one-day course designed for the experienced but unlicensed rider to become licensed and legal. Many experienced, licensed riders use this course as a refresher and skills tune-up. Topics include: braking, counter-steering, turning, speed judgment, and other techniques necessary for the experienced rider to operate a motorcycle skillfully and safely. **Each student must provide his or her own motorcycle, riding gear, and proof of insurance.** Scooters will be allowed in this class. The cycle must be titled, properly registered, and display a valid license plate and must pass a safety inspection. Successful completion of this course and its knowledge and skills test will result in a riding and written test waiver by the Secretary of State. (8 Contact Hours)

# Motorcycle Basic Rider Web Enhanced Course FAQ

- **What is the Basic Rider Web Enhanced Course?**

This class consists of approximately 18 hours of instruction – 3 hours of online preparation to be completed prior to your class start date, 5 hours of classroom instruction, and 10 hours of hands-on training. Designed for someone who has minimal experience operating a motorcycle, this course focuses on the development of basic riding skills: clutch and throttle coordination, straight-line riding, braking, turning, and shifting. Successful completion of this course and its knowledge and skills tests will result in a riding and written test waiver by the Secretary of State.

- **Are there any prerequisites for the Basic Rider Web Enhanced Course?**

There are three:

- 1) **Students must provide a valid email address upon registration.**
- 2) Students must have the ability to ride a bicycle.
- 3) Students must complete the online eCourse portion prior to class start.

- **I see that the schedule for Saturday and Sunday is 8AM – 6PM, will I be there the whole time?**

No – Range Times will be assigned the first night of class (approximately 5 hours per day)

- **How do I access the eCourse?**

A link to the eCourse will be *emailed* to all registered Basic Rider Web Enhanced Course students at least one week prior to the class start date. **Students need to complete the eCourse prior to arriving to their first class session.** Because access to the link will be provided via email, it is *imperative* for all registered students to provide a valid email address upon registering with Macomb Community College. If you do not receive this email one week prior to class, please send your request to [motorcycle@macomb.edu](mailto:motorcycle@macomb.edu).

- **How long does the online portion of the course take?**

The online portion takes a **minimum of 3 hours** to complete. Students will have the option of going at a slower pace and/or repeating segments, if necessary. Students will also have the ability to complete the course in multiple sittings.

- **What if I do not have computer/internet access – can I still take the course?**

Yes, students without computer and/or internet access can use the computers at a local library.

- **What equipment do I need to bring on the first night of class?**

- 1) A printed copy or snapshot of eCourse completion **certificate**

- **How much does the class cost?**

**The course cost is \$50.00 (non-refundable).** There is no additional fee for the eCourse portion

## Frequently Asked Questions

- 1) When I enter the course, I only see a blank white page.**  
 This is an issue often experienced with Internet Explorer. Try to either minimize or maximize your screen. If this doesn't work, please make sure you have the latest version of Adobe Flash Player. Lastly, if neither of the above work, try another browser.
- 2) The course does not load correctly on my iPad.**  
 The MSF course is not currently compatible with iPads or other tablets. Please use a desktop or laptop computer.
- 3) My completion certificate is not enabled even though I've completed the course.**  
 This occurs when the last slide of the presentation does not play through completion (until the voice-over ends). Please re-launch the course and let the last slide play all the way through and try the certificate link once again.
- 4) My certificate is showing an incorrect date.**  
 This occurs when the last slide of the presentation does not play through completion (until the voice-over ends). Please re-launch the course and let the last slide play all the way through and try the certificate link once again.

## 2022 Motorcycle Rider and Safety Education Program

The Motorcycle Rider and Safety Education program is conducted with Michigan Safety Education funds from a grant administered by the Michigan Secretary of State.

All motorcycle classes require students to have the following riding gear and safety equipment for the first riding session:

- Students will be required to follow all COVID19 protocols including, but not limited to: the wearing of Face Masks indoors are required, social distancing and reporting of any communicable disease.
- Motorcycle Helmet – DOT-approved or SNELL-certified
- Long sleeve jacket or heavy shirt
- Heavy duty long pants – Denim or material of equivalent durability
- Eye protection – goggles or glasses (required even with a face shield helmet)
- Full fingered gloves – Should be fitted and not bulky to allow proper gripping. Leather is preferred but not required.
- Boots (ankles must be covered and boot must have a hard sole – high heels or high-top tennis shoes are not permitted)
- Rain and cold weather gear, as needed. Classes are not cancelled due to inclement weather. Be sure to bring gear to protect you from the elements.

Due to State of Michigan training requirements for the Motorcycle Endorsement, you must be on time to class and attend all sessions. ***Late arrivals will not be admitted into class.***

Students are allowed to take the Basic Rider Web Enhanced or the Basic Rider 2 courses starting at age 15, if they have a valid driver's license. All students under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian accompany them to the first class meeting. Parent signatures are required on some documents.
