Scholarship for Lifelong Learning Application

The Scholarship for Lifelong Learning was established by Dr. Donald J. Amboyer to foster lifelong learning by providing financial assistance to students enrolled in Workforce & Continuing Education courses at Macomb Community College. Financial need and enrollment in C⁴K courses through Workforce & Continuing Education are foremost when considering scholarship applicants. Scholarship awards are for tuition and fees only. Funds for this scholarship are provided by private donors and organizations.

Criteria for Eligibility

- The student must be enrolled or planning to enroll in a C⁴K course at the Macomb Community College through Workforce & Continuing Education. These programs are described in the current WCE Schedule of Classes.
- The applicant must complete a C⁴K Scholarship for Lifelong Learning Application, including statements describing educational goals and financial need.
- A letter of recommendation from a school counselor, teacher, coach or other professional must accompany the application.
- Students are eligible to receive this scholarship only once per year.

Disbursement of Funds

- The community will be made aware of the availability of this scholarship through an announcement in the Workforce & Continuing Education Schedule of Classes and on the C⁴K webpage, distributed prior to the start of each semester.
- A three-member committee comprised of members of the WCE staff will review all applications and determine award recipients.
- Awards will not exceed one half of the cost of tuition and fees for specific Continuing Education C⁴K programs.
