

The Macomb Community College Medical Assistant Program is pleased to offer a program designed for the experienced medical assistant. This program will allow the candidate to gain credit for experience, take required coursework, graduate from an accredited school, and be able to take the CMA (AAMA) exam.

As of January 2014 only credentialed medical assistants, as well as licensed health professionals, are permitted to enter medication, radiology, and laboratory orders into the electronic health record (EHR), and have such entry count towards Meaningful Use, Stage 2, thresholds under the Medicare and Medicaid EHR Incentive Programs.

Experienced medical assistants will receive credit for prior learning in a variety of ways:

- Credit by examination for Medical Assistant pre-requisite Medical Terminology and required courses: Applied Math for Medical Assistants, Body Systems 1, Body Systems 2, and Pharmacology for Health Professionals
- CLEP (College Level Examination Program) for pre-requisite Psychology and/or Composition
- Submission of portfolio with letter from employer verifying employment of a minimum of two years experience as a medical assistant in either the front office or clinical back office.
