Depending on your device, the downloaded e-book may show up as a download on the device (for example, in the upper right of the Google Chrome browser on a Windows laptop, as below), or you might need to open ADE on your device to see your downloaded e-book.



The digital editions (ADE) on your device also needs to be authorized before you can see the downloaded book. If you are on a computer, open up ADE and choose Help/Authorize. On an iPad, open up ADE and choose the horizontal lined menu in the upper left, then Settings. You can authorize your device without entering your Adobe ID and Password. However some features, like transferring between devices, will not be available to you.
