3. Students must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 in the Associate Degree Nursing program to transfer to Detroit Mercy.
4. Students must apply and be admitted to the University of Detroit Mercy School of Nursing.
5. Students must successfully pass the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN) prior to taking courses in the BSN degree completion sequence and possess an unrestricted nursing license.
6. *BIOL 2400 – Note: BIOL 1000 (with a grade of C or better) is a pre-requisite course for BIOL 2400.
