Outlined below are the required prerequisites for the Macomb Community College Collaborative Radiologic Technology Hospital Based Program. All prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better before the student may apply for entry into the Collaborative Radiologic Technology Hospital Based Program. Students may complete the prerequisite courses in any order, and may take longer than one year to complete, if desired.

When the student has completed all prerequisite courses, the student must submit this application by **February 1st** to Department of Health Science Technology, Center Campus, R163. Additionally the student must submit an application to the desired collaborative hospital by **February 1st**. The student must successfully complete all prerequisites for the program by the end of the Fall term ending in December to be considered for the program. Applications received after **February 1st** will not be processed. Students who do not complete their prerequisites by the end of the Fall semester will **not** be considered for acceptance into the program.

Macomb Community College transcripts will be provided for this application.

The above courses must be taken for college credit. After the completion of the hospital component of the program students will be granted a block of 30 credits in radiologic technology and be eligible for an Associate of Applied Science in Radiologic Technology and therefore be eligible to apply for certification as a Radiologic Technologist. Students must officially apply for their degree by completing and submitting the Macomb Community College Certificate/Degree Application form. Students transferring credits from another accredited college or university must complete a minimum of 15 semester credit hours at Macomb Community College. For courses taken outside of Macomb an official transcript must be sent to Macomb Enrollment Office.
