Articulation Agreement between Macomb Community College and Macomb County Schools

This agreement is made this 8^{th} day of July 2018, by and between Macomb Community College and the following Macomb County High Schools:

WHEREAS, the parties wish and intend by the Agreement to set forth the terms and conditions of engaging in an educational program to help eligible participating students continue their education toward an Associate Degree in Culinary Arts.

Macomb Community College and the above High Schools agree that students successfully graduating from the Hospitality/Culinary Arts Program (CIP 12.9999) at their high school who meet the following requirements will receive select credit in the Culinary Arts Program (CIP 12.0503) at Macomb Community College.

- 1. Student must successfully complete their high school Hospitality/Culinary Arts program with a minimum 80% (B) average and an overall GPA of 2.0 AND earn ProStart and ServSafe Certifications.
- 2. Student must receive recommendation from high school Hospitality/Culinary Arts instructor.
- 3. Student must enroll in the Culinary Arts program at Macomb Community College within 3 years of high school graduation.
- 4. Course credit will be added to the student's transcript upon successful completion of one required Culinary course at Macomb Community College.
- 5. Applicants for credit must meet all college admission requirements and be an enrolled/registered student in good standing.

Upon completion of one culinary course, student will receive credit for:

CULH-1155- Sanitation (2.00 Credits)

These institutions agree to communicate concerning curriculum changes which affect the agreed upon relationships between articulated courses at the respective schools.

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties, and all prior discussions, agreements, and understandings, whether verbal or in writing, are hereby merged into this Agreement.

No amendment or modification to this Agreement, including any amendment or modification of this paragraph, shall be effective unless the same is in writing and signed by all parties.

These agreements are housed within the Office of Admissions & Outreach and posted on the college website.

This agreement expires June 30, 2020. The discard date is June 30, 2022.
