

Articulation Agreement
between
Macomb Community College
and
Restaurant Opportunities Center of Michigan

This agreement is made this 13th date of September 2016, by and between Macomb Community College and Restaurant Opportunities Center of Michigan (ROC-MI).

WHEREAS, the parties wish and intend by the Agreement to set forth the terms and conditions of engaging in an educational program to help eligible participating students continue their education toward an Associate Degree in Culinary Arts.


Macomb Community College and ROC-MI agree that students successfully graduating from ROC-MI's restaurant training program and who meet the following requirements will receive select credit in the Culinary Arts program at Macomb Community College.

1. Student must successfully complete the ROC-MI training program with a passing grade on the ServSafe Alcohol Safety exam in order to receive credit for CULH 1155 Sanitation. Student must successfully complete the ROC-MI training program with a passing grade on the American Hotel and Lodging Institute Restaurant Server exam and server audit in order to receive credit for CULH 1255 Table Service.
2. Student must receive a recommendation from ROC-MI instructor(s).
3. Student must enroll in the Culinary Arts program at Macomb Community College within one year of graduation from ROC-MI's training program.
4. Course credit will be added to the student's transcript upon successful completion of one required Culinary Arts course at Macomb Community College. Regular tuition and fees for credit granted under this agreement will be waived.
5. Applicants for credit must meet all college admission requirements and be an enrolled/registered student in good standing.

Upon completion of one culinary course, student will receive credit for:

CULH-1155 Sanitation (2.00 Credits) or CULH-1255-Table Service (3.00 Credits) or both based on #1 above.


