

Michigan Transfer Agreement

A Transfer Option You Can Count On!

What is the Michigan Transfer Agreement?

The Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) facilitates the transfer of up to 30 credits from Macomb (or any other Michigan community college) to all four-year public colleges and universities in Michigan, and many private ones as well. It is replacing the MACRAO Transfer Agreement.

Who can take advantage of it?

Any new or returning student enrolling at a community college may select the MTA to satisfy 30 general education credits toward a bachelor's degree, which is especially beneficial to those students who have not yet decided on a major but still intend to transfer to a four-year college or university.

What about students currently following the MACRAO Transfer Agreement?

They may choose to continue under the MACRAO terms, which will remain in effect through summer 2019, or choose to follow the terms of the MTA if it better meets their academic goals.

How does the MTA work?

Students take 30 credits in select core (general education) courses at a community college, which can then be applied (transferred) to the requirements of a bachelor's degree at participating four-year colleges and universities in Michigan. Students may apply these credits to an associate degree program at Macomb or take them only for the purpose of transferring. Either way, a student saves money on the cost of their college education because Macomb's tuition is considerably less than that of a four-year college or university.

What courses are required for the MTA?

- English: 1-2 courses
- Humanities & Fine Arts: 2 courses
- Oral Communication: 0-1 course
- Social Sciences: 2 courses
- Mathematics: 1 course
- Natural Sciences: 2 courses (one must be a lab)

How do I get started?

Meet with a Macomb counselor or academic advisor as soon as possible! They will be able to help you decide if the MTA is right for you and will help you choose the right courses to meet your individual needs.
