Humanities & Fine Arts	Select from two different subjects	2 courses
Mathematics	Select at least one from the following: College Algebra, Statistics, Quantitative Reasoning (a.k.a. Everyday Math), or an advanced level course in any of these areas.	1 course
Sciences	Select from two different subjects, with one course containing a lab	2 courses
Social Sciences	Select from two different subjects	2 courses
Total Credits	Minimum 30 credits
