

Macomb Coursework – Before Transfer:

Candidates for the Macomb Associate of General Studies (AGS)* degree will complete both the Transfer Block & Competency Requirements and all courses required for the Academic Major/Core. Associate of Applied Science (AAS)** degree candidates will complete all Macomb requirements for their associate's degree plus 40 credit hours from the Transfer block & Competency Requirements and Academic Major/Core. There will be overlap between coursework for the associate's degree and the requirements below. Work with an academic advisor to maximize your transfer credit.
