<b>Before Transfer:</b> Meet with a Walsh College advisor for assistance with additional course planning and selections. Up to an additional 20 credits may be completed at Macomb College. Walsh College will accept a maximum of 82 credits which must include 30 credits of general education coursework. Specific courses meet this requirement and a Walsh College advisor will calculate your general education credits*. Possible courses for transfer with advisor approval: ACCT 2180, 2190, 2300; ITCS 1010; MATH 1000; MGMT 2100 or PSYC 2400	20
