## Tutoring Services

Successful students know the value of interacting with a tutor and their peers. Come early, come regularly, and come prepared! Group tutoring services are available to Macomb students for the courses in which they are currently enrolled.

## Testing Services

Macomb Community College offers various testing opportunities to place and advance students so that they can successfully complete their educational goals. Official photo identification with signature (e.g. driver's license, passport, military ID, Macomb student ID w/ photo) is required for all tests administered by the Learning Centers. Electronic equipment (cell phones, laptops, tablets, etc.) and personal items are not allowed in the testing rooms. A locker will be provided for these items.

### HESI Admission Assessment™ (A<sup>2</sup>) Exam

Completion of the HESI Admission Assessment™ (A<sup>2</sup>) Exam is part of the requirements for consideration for admission to the Macomb Community College Nursing Program. See the selective admissions packet or the Learning Center website for more information.

### Make-up Examinations

The Learning Centers provide testing services to currently enrolled students who were unable to take a classroom test. Faculty will make arrangements with the Learning Center.

### Proctored Examinations

The South Campus Learning Center provides test proctors and testing facilities, for a fee, to non-Macomb students and educational institutions. ## Credit for Prior Learning

Students interested in saving time or money by earning college credit at Macomb for prior learning and experiences have several options available to them. For more information, visit [www.macomb.edu](http://www.macomb.edu) [SEARCH: Credit for Prior Learning]. The following exams are administered by appointment for a fee:

- **College Level Examination Program (CLEP)** — Individuals may receive credit by passing exams that measure knowledge in various subject and general course areas. Any individual who properly registers may take the CLEP examination at Macomb. Enrollment is not required. Registration information and recommended resources are available at the Learning Centers and on [www.macomb.edu](http://www.macomb.edu) (SEARCH: CLEP).
- **Credit by Examination** — Tests are scheduled on an appointment basis and do not replace grades for courses taken at Macomb.
- **DANTES Subject Standardized Test Program (DSST)** — A series of more than 30 exams that allow students to earn credit for upper-level as well as introductory college courses. These exams are recommended for credit by the American Council on Education and can help accelerate your path to degree completion, saving time and money. Exams are administered by appointment only.

## Special Needs Services

Macomb understands the challenges many of us face to achieve our goals. In the event a student has a documented disability that requires special accommodations, the Learning Centers may provide one-on-one tutoring, group tutoring, scribes, test readers, and additional accommodations free of charge. Students with disabilities who need accommodations must notify the Office of Special Services (586.286.2237 or 586.445.7420) in advance of the start of classes.
